### Culture on Prescription in Germany

The Erasmus+ project Culture on Prescription is led by ISIS Institut für Soziale Infrastruktur and implemented in Germany together with the Health Department of the City of Frankfurt am Main. The project aims to prevent and combat social isolation and loneliness through art and culture. In this way, the Culture on Prescription project will contribute to better health and increase well-being. In Frankfurt, courses on art and theatre will be offered to support lonely adults in the region.

Following a mix of desk research and interviews with experts from the fields of psychology, medicine, politics, adult education and pedagogy, exciting insights into the potential of the Culture on Prescription approach have already been gathered.
