FIRST KICK-OFF

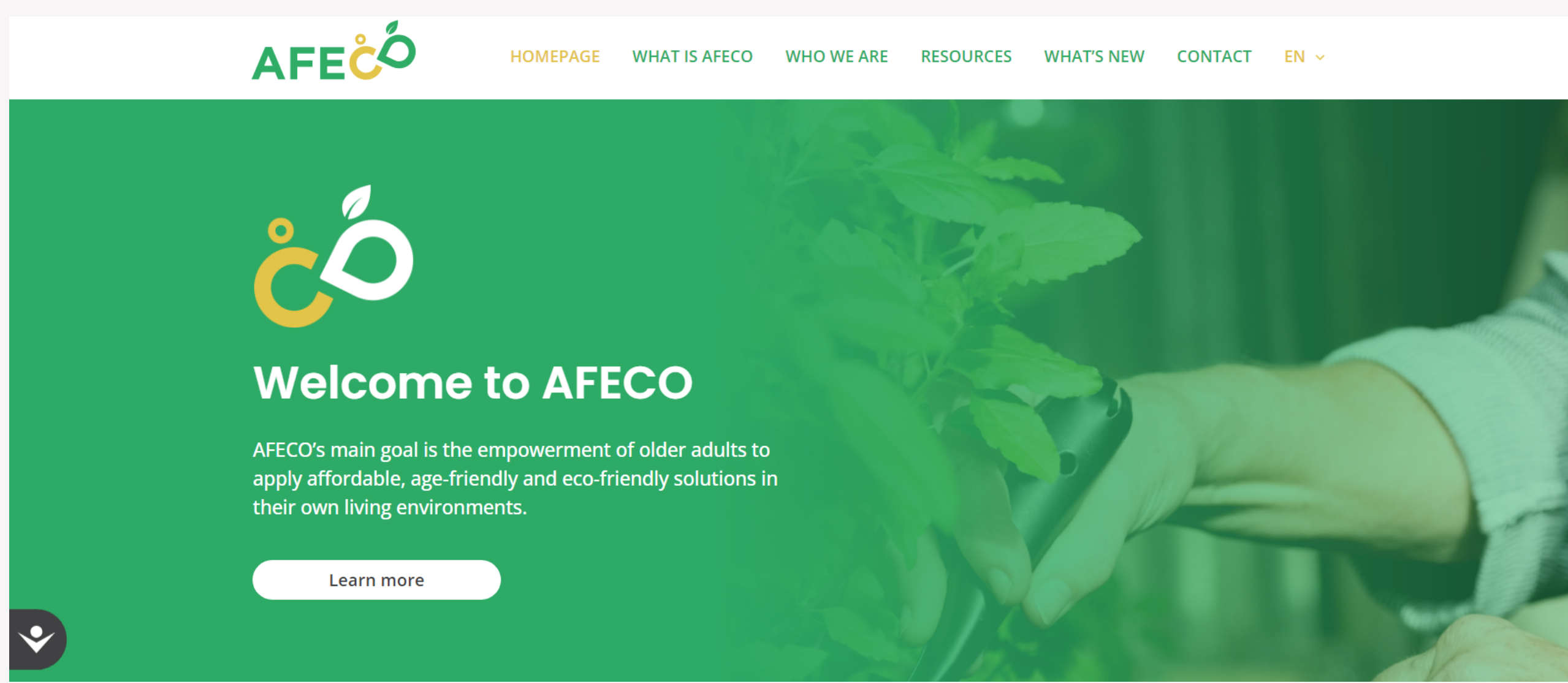
The hybrid kick-off meeting was held on January 18 and 19, 2023, in Gouda, The Netherlands.

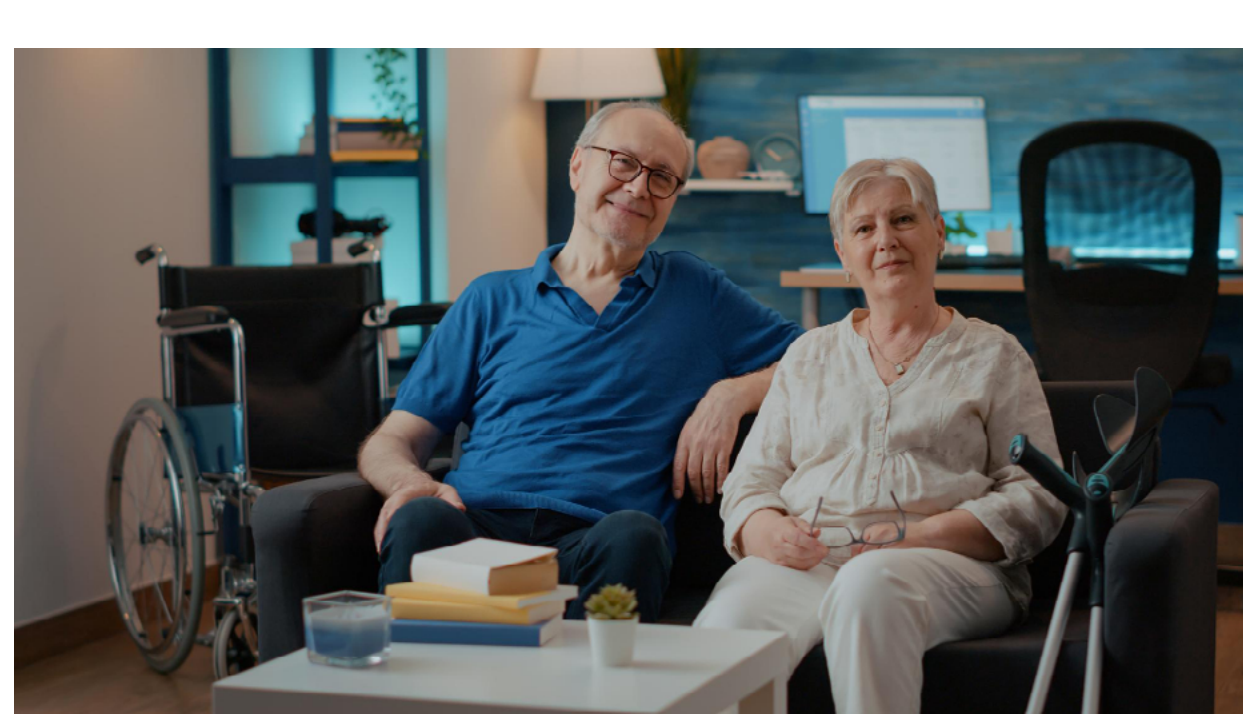


NATIONAL REPORTS

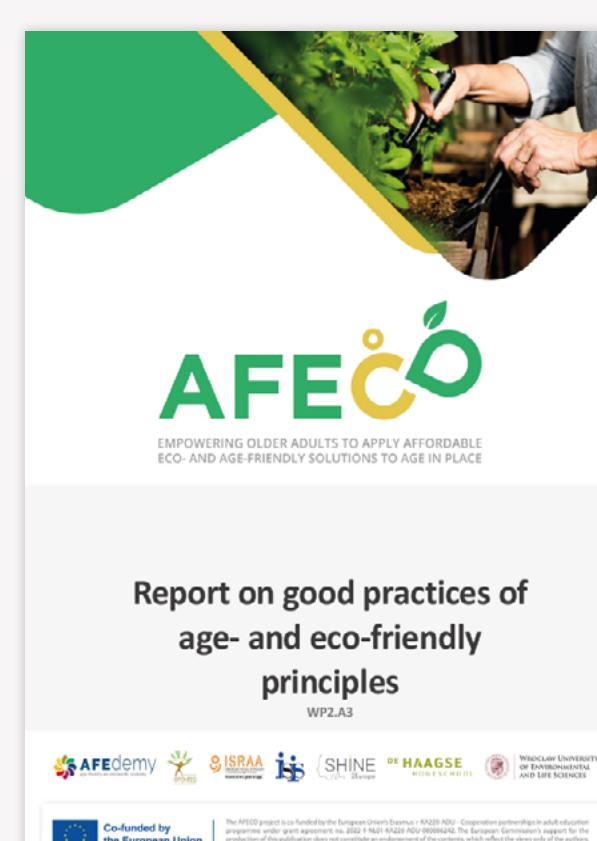
COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS

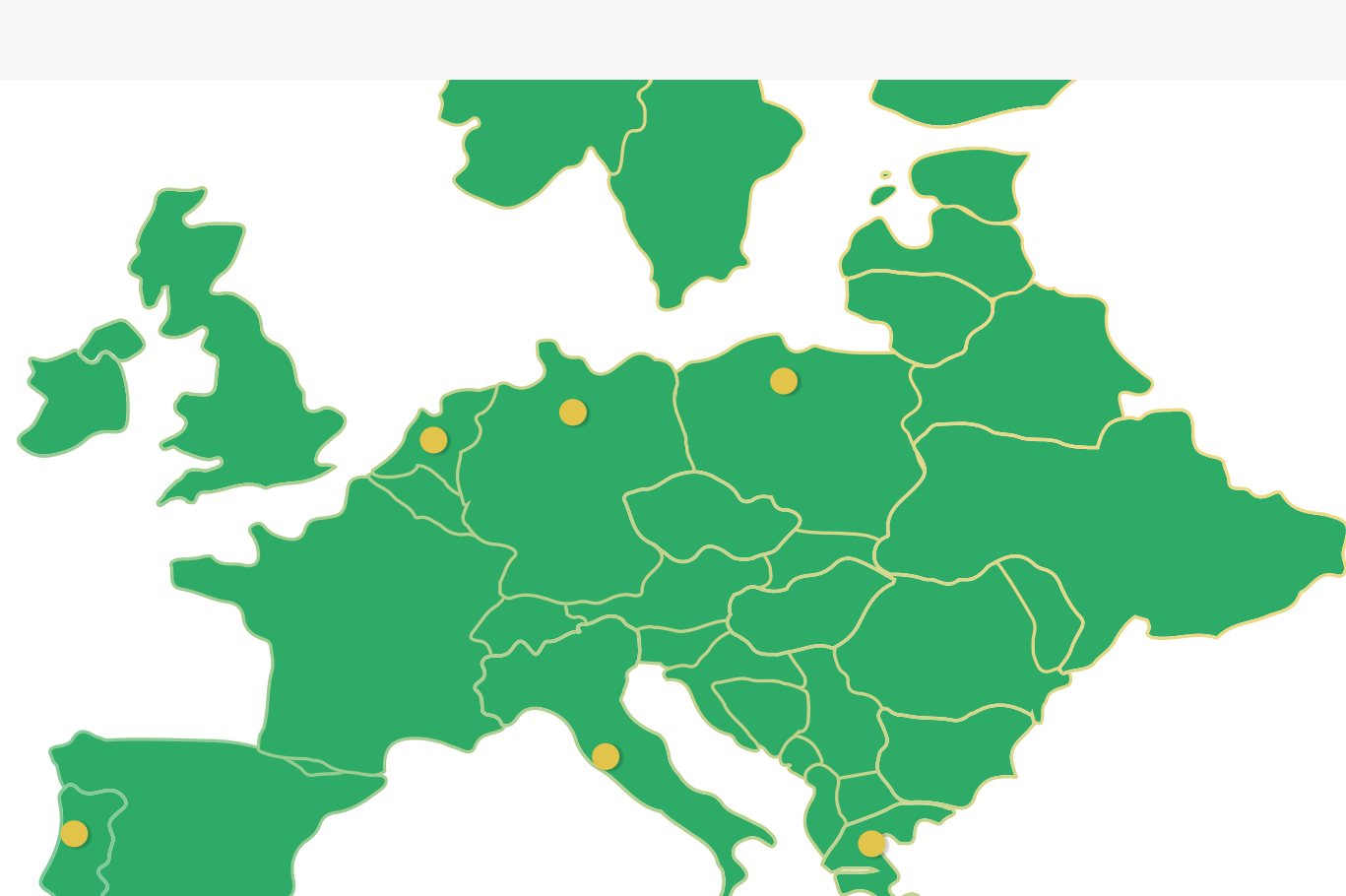
